We will be using 7 Fields with Pat Traps and Throwing White Flyer Targets.

Ties shoot off. If any shooter eligible for a trophy fails to report for a shoot-off they forfeit their right to any trophy.

The members of our Handicapping and Classification Committee shall act as judges for any controversy between a contestant and a score-puller, etc.

No entry may be changed after the events start.

Should a shooter win or tie in any class event, it shall be the shooter's duty to report to the Handicapping and Classification Committee to have his/her classification changed.
