Your MTA Officers and the Board of Directors welcome you to the 2014 Minnesota State Zone Trap Shoot. The MTA Board considers these shoots a major State event, and we encourage all Minnesota shooters to attend.

The purpose of the Zone Shoots is to promote area clubs and to encourage local competition. The Zone Shoots are also used to select a Zone Mens Champion, Zone Ladies Champion, Zone Veteran Champion, Zone Senior Veteran Champion, Zone Sub-Junior Champion, Zone Junior Champion, and a Zone Team. These Zone winners will compete at the State Shoot to establish Zone Champion of Champions, in each category and a State Zone Team Champion.

At the Zone level, all individual Champions are selected on the combined total of the 200 16-yard Championship targets and the 100 Championship Handicap targets. The Zone Team members are selected by class - one from each class: AA, A, B, C, D - based only on their score in the Champion 16-yard event. Handicap scores are not used to determine the members of the Zone team. No individual Champion will also represent the Zone on the Zone Team.

Because of the possibility that an individual champion or a team member may not attend the State Shoot, first and second alternates will be selected for each position.

REGISTERED SHOOT CERTIFICATION
