DONATIONS NEEDED!! DID YOU KNOW that 100% of the Live & Silent Auction proceeds benefit ATA youth shooting programs in Minnesota? The auctions, as well as Youth Day (July 3, 2017) and the AIM Championship (July 8, 2017), are organized and run by the Minnesota Youth Shotgun Association (mySA), a 501c3 nonprofit organization.

The partnership between the MTA & mySA guarantees that all auction monies are restricted for use only with ATA youth programs, such as reduced-price targets during the State Shoot, and free ATA membership for brand new ATA shooters when they attend their first MTA shoot! Last year over \$7000 was raised from the auctions, but the annual cost was over \$10,000. This year, two silent auctions will be run—one on Youth Day only, and one for the rest of the State week.
