Summer League has begun!

The 2013 Owatonna Gun Club Summer League is now forming and will begin competition on Sunday, June 2nd. The format of the Summer League will be as it has been in the past with shooters shooting our end of year party 300 targets over the course of three months' time. You may shoot ahead or behind if you so choose, the only requirement is that your league rounds must be complete by Wednesday, August 28th to be scored for

your team. Sponsor fees for summer teams remain at \$50. Individual membership for the 2013 calendar year is \$20 and for those participating in the Summer League, also includes which will be held on Wednesday, September 4th this year.

Winter League

Once again we had a shortened Winter League. Despite the unusually warm winter we did not open the months of December, January and February.
