What's New for 2017?

SILENT AUCTION on Monday, July 3rd at Alex Shooting Park!

In partnership with the Minnesota Trapshooting Association, the Minnesota Youth Shotgun Association (a 501c3 nonprofit) runs silent and live auctions during the Minnesota State Shoot. All proceeds earned from these auctions benefit youth ATA shooting in Minnesota, including free ATA membership for all first-time Minnesota youth and reduced price targets throughout the Minnesota State Shoot.

In 2016, the total cost of these two youth program was \$10,559.

Any **youth shoot** who is a Minnesota resident in these age categories may enter. Must be an ATA Member to participate. Memberships (\$12 annually) are available at the shoot; youth shooters receive their 1st ATA membership FREE courtesy of the MTA. Must provide own shells. Food & beverages available for sale on site.

ATA's AIM youth categories will be used for this event:

Junior Gold (100 target event)	Age 18-22
Junior (100 target event)	Age 15-17
Sub-Junior (100 target event)	Age 12-14
Pre-Sub (100 target event)	Age 11 & under

This event is both a **TEAM** and **INDIVIDUAL** competition. Teams may be comprised of multiple age categories with the highest age category determining the team category only. (Example: 3 sub-juniors, 1 pre-sub and 1 junior shooter join together to make a team. The highest age category on the team is junior therefore the entire team is classified as a junior team for team awards. However, for individual awards, each youth shooter competes within their own age category, regardless of their team designation).

Champion and Runner-Up awards are given to teams in each age category. Awards are given to individuals in each age category using the Lewis class system. For more information please visit www.minnesotashotgun.org.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUTH DAY

How many targets are in the competition? This is a 100-target competition for all age categories (Pre-Sub, Sub-Jr, Junior, Junior Gold) and your score is used for both individual and team awards (if applicable). Teams are made of 5 shooters who all must compete on the same squad.

Is it expensive for my youth shooter to participate? No, in fact the MTA provides reduced pricing of only \$20/100 targets plus \$3MTA/\$3ATA fees (\$26 total) for Youth Day and all week of the MTA State Shoot. Free ATA memberships are also available to new youth shooters on Monday—you can sign up and register to shoot all at the same time.

Do I have to bring my own shells? YES. Shells are also available for purchase on site.

Does the MTA take credit cards or debit cards? No, cash or checks only. There is no ATM onsite so please make sure your shooter comes prepared.

What else should I bring with me? If you have one, bring your ATA membership card (the hard blue or orange card with your ATA number on it), your ATA average card, a check or cash for registration, your gun and shooting supplies, and be prepared for a fantastic day! Many shooters also bring a small cooler with food & drinks; lunch is available for purchase on the grounds.

What time should I arrive? Registration begins at 8:00am so plan to come early and be prepared ahead of shooting time, especially if you are looking to join a team or for someone to complete your team. Shooting begins promptly at 9:00am.

I'm a Junior but my friends are Sub-Juniors. Can we shoot together and compete as a team? YES! While your age category determines individual competition, team award

I do not have a team. Can I still compete? Absolutely! Youth Day is both a team and an individual competition. Sometimes there are partial teams looking for shooters in their category to make a full team too, so check with shoot staff when you get to this year's Youth Day for more information.

When will trophies be awarded? The Awards Ceremony will convene 1 hour after the Youth Event has completed. Photos and results will be posted at www.minnesotatrap.com and www.minnesotashotgun.org.
