### **Statement of Financial Position**

1. Total cash in banks at 12/31/2024 was \$150,893 and 12/31/2023 was \$143,221. The balances increased by \$7,672.

### **Statement of Activities**

1. The gross revenues for 12/31/2024 were \$191,169 vs \$192,381 for 12/31/2023. The state shoot lost \$2,139 for 2024 and had a profit of \$1,915 for 2023.
2. The overall net profit for the organization for 2024 was \$6,154 and 2023 was \$5,278.
3. During 2024, the organization did receive the ATA rebate of \$5,382 and MTA Daily Fees of \$18,501.
