Treasurer's Report

Statement of Financial Position

1. Total cash in banks at 12/31/2021 was \$168,303 and 12/31/2020 was \$149,810. The balances increased by \$18,492.

Statement of Activities

1. The gross revenues for 12/31/2021 were \$157,172 vs \$189,387 for 12/31/2019. The state shoot lost \$8,310 for 2021.
2. The overall net loss for the organization for 2021 was \$6,030.
3. During 2021, the organization did receive the ATA rebate of \$3,622 and MTA Daily Fees of \$14,033.
4. In 2022, the organization did receive the ATA rebate for 2021 of \$5,166.
