## **Secretary's Report**

Shawn King read the secretary's report from the July 2019 annual meeting. Dave Smith moved to approve the secretary's report at read, Tom Suter seconded, motion carried

## **Treasurer's Report**

### **Statement of Financial Position**

1. Total cash in banks at 12/31/2020 was \$149,810 and at 12/31/2019 was \$179,623. The balances decreased by \$29,813.
2. The reason for the decrease in cash was the purchase of the raffle prizes (\$10,399) and the 2020 shoot trophies that are carried as inventory to the 2021 state shoot (\$15,624).

### **Statement of Activities**

1. The gross revenues for 12/31/2019 were \$189,387. The state shoot lost \$6,889 for 2019.
2. The overall net loss for the organization for 2019 was \$2,041.
3. During 2020, the organization did receive the ATA rebate of \$6,169 and MTA Daily Fees of \$5,336.
4. In 2021, the organization did receive the ATA rebate for 2020 of \$3,622.
